Arrival Time: Animals may start arriving after 12 noon on Thursday June 4 or anytime June 5. Show animal check in will start Friday at 12 and run through the start of the exhibitor's potluck meeting at 6 pm. Check in will also be available after the exhibitors meeting until the conclusion of the buck show. No animals will be checked in after the conclusion of the buck show Friday or Saturday night. All show animals must be checked in by 7:30 am to show on Saturday, and by 7:30 am on Sunday. Show starts at 8 am on Saturday. Showmanship will start at 8 am Sunday, and will immediately be followed by the Sr. Doe Show. Ring assignment and show order will be explained at the exhibitor's meeting Friday night.

The order of the show is subject to change. The Junior and Senior doe shows are separately sanctioned. The Sr Doe shows are sanctioned for the following breeds: LaMancha, Recorded Grade, Nubian, Oberhasli, Alpine, Nigerian Dwarf, All Other Purebred, Saanen. The Junior Doe Shows are sanctioned for the following breeds: Alpine, LaMancha, Nubian, All Other Purebred, Recorded Grade, Saanen, and Nigerian Dwarf. The Buck shows are combined sanction for the following breeds: Nigerian Dwarf, All Other Purebred, LaMancha, Nubian, and Alpine.

The show order will be explained during the Friday night exhibitors' meeting. Because we are trying to move a large number of animals through our show, we are making every attempt to make the show run smoothly. We request everyone make every effort to attend the exhibitor's meeting at 6pm on Friday to help make this happen. All animals will be shown under both judges over the course of the day's show. The judges and show secretaries will move from ring to ring to accommodate judging in both rings. Breeds will remain in assigned rings and will not have to travel between rings to be judged. As always, multi breed exhibitors need to have additional handlers so that classes are not delayed. If an owner refuses to allow someone else to handle their animal, that animal might miss its class. Each breed ring will begin when the majority of the animals are present at the discretion of the show staff.

ADGA Sanctioned Open Dairy Goat Shows

-Open to the World-

All Shows **ARE** sanctioned separately by the American Dairy Goat Association and their rules shall govern. Only ADGA, AGS and CGS registered, recorded or applied-for animals may be shown in an official American Dairy Goat Association show.

- Entry fee is \$6 per animal per ring (discounted to \$20 per animal to show in all four rings) if received by May 29. Late entries received after May 29 will be \$8 per animal per ring (discounted to \$28 per animal to show in all four rings).
- Pen rentals are \$10 each for a 10'x12' open stall, or \$6 each for 5'x5' pens. Pens will be assigned by show personnel, and exhibitors are not allowed to claim their pens prior to check-in. Tack pens may be limited to insure adequate pens are available for goats. Entry & pen fees must accompany entry form for entries to be considered. Substitutions are discouraged, but will be allowed within breed during specified check-in times. There will be no refunds of fees paid. - Emailed entries will be accepted but animals will not be counted in the final tally of entries until the entry fees are paid in full.
- The base date for computing ages is the respective date of show. There is no pre-show milk-out.

- The original registration certificate is required for all animals six months of age or older and MUST be shown to the Show Secretary before the start of the show.
- The original registration certificate or duplicate application stamped by the ADGA office is required for all animals under six months of age and this MUST be shown to the Show Secretary before the start of the show.
- No copies of registration certificate or the stamped duplicate application, telegrams or phone calls will be accepted in lieu of the original certificate.
- All animals entering the grounds must be healthy. Health papers are not required for animals originating in North Carolina. For out-of-state animals, health certificates are required, as well as negative brucellosis and TB tests within 30 days or herd certifications and accreditation unless animals are from states that are certified "TB and Brucellosis Free" by the USDA (check with your veterinarian). A health check of all animals will be made on the grounds and suspect/unhealthy animals will be barred from entry. When you submit your entry, you agree to abide by the decision of show officials.
- All animals must be checked in with attending health inspectors and the show superintendent during the prescribed check in times.
- If your animal is awarded a GCH or RGCH, you must have your registration papers available for immediate viewing by the judge. Please verify all information on the official show sheet prior to signing the Report of Awards.
- Exhibitors are responsible for their providing their own feed and bedding. Initial bedding of sawdust
 will be provided in each pen. Additional bedding of shavings, if desired, will be available for purchase
 for \$5/bag at the show. The fairground does not allow straw bedding.
- Judging will begin in Ring 1 and Ring 2 at the posted start times on the schedule of events.
- Breeds will remain as posted in assigned rings and will not travel between rings 1 & 2 to be judged.
 The judges and show secretaries will move from ring to ring to accommodate judging of breeds in both rings. This will be fully explained at the exhibitors' meeting.
- The Jr Doe Shows will start at the conclusion of the Sr Doe shows. Friday night buck show will start at 7 pm. Saturday Buck shows will start after the conclusion of the Jr Doe Shows.
- Friday afternoon **Showmanship clinic** starts at **4 pm**
- **Friday night Exhibitor's meeting and potluck starts at 6 pm.** Please make every effort to attend as we will be discussing the ring assignments and movement of breeds within the shows.
